Reviewers in the Newcombe competition will benefit from your assessment of this student's strengths and weaknesses; the significance of the project; the student's ability to carry it out successfully; and prospects for completion by August 2011. In your letter, please comment on the applicant's qualifications for this award, addressing particularly the following matters, as well as any others you consider relevant:

- the student's ability to do scholarly research and writing;
- any major problems presented by the topic;
- feasibility of the timetable for completion;
- whether you will be available for consultation during the period of the award; and
- the contribution of the dissertation to understanding Religious and Ethical values.

 - If letterhead is not available, please just use traditional formatting for return address
 - Letters may be directed, collectively, to the Woodrow Wilson Newcombe Selection Committee.
 - Please indicate your title and department, and note whether you are the applicant's dissertation director.
 - Please sign and date your letter, with electronic signature *if* possible.
3. Attach the Microsoft WORD or RTF document to your email.
 - Please do not type the letter within the body of the email—send it as an attachment.
